STEM Club

We are really pleased to be able to offer an after-school STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) Club running on a Wednesday for 8 weeks, beginning on **Wednesday 2 February 2022** in science room **S2**.

The theme of the STEM Club is 'Saving the World' and will look to engage students in practical activities that make them think beyond the curriculum about how science can help sustain and improve the world around us. The activities will cover biology, chemistry and physics and develop both knowledge and skills through practical work. At the end of the 8 weeks students will be offered the chance to sign up for the [Youth STEMM award](#) – details will be forwarded nearer the time.

The club will be limited to **24** students and sign up is required. Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis and sign up must be made by **Wednesday 26 January 2022**.

Please include your child's name and year group in your email. Please note that the club will include both Year 9 and Year 10 students; it will be led by a science teacher and supported by sixth form students.

This is a really exciting opportunity for students and one we hope many will be keen to sign up for. If interest exceeds capacity we will look to run another repeated club in the summer term, keeping a list of interested students on the reserve list.
