





The Next Two Years...

- Sciences (Combined = 2 GCSEs, Separate = 3 GCSEs)
- PE (core is non-examined, GCSE is examined)
- Religious Studies and Personal Development
- 4 options choice subjects
- L2 Further Maths












GCSEs are hard!

- Different for different people.
- Key measures are 4+ and 5+ in English and Maths.
- Those without 4+ must resit post-16.
- To access THS sixth form you need six GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English and Maths.



Look at targets set at assessment point 1.



Significant factors for success:

- Excellent attendance









Research suggests that a Year 10/11 pupil who misses 17 days or more during their school year, will get one grade less at GCSE.

90% attendance = ½ day missed every week!!

Mon	Tue	W	ed	Thur	Fri
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1 school year at 90% attendance = 4 whole weeks of lessons
MISSED!!!






Significant factors for success:

- Excellent attendance
- Willing attitude
- Lots of positives (no negatives)
- Organisation (equipment/homework/revision)
- Resilience (to feedback, to struggles, to tiredness)

Be open to feedback...









Basics:

- A place to study
- Equipment
- Get them up and out of bed
- Feed them
- Water them
- Give them sunlight!
- Create downtime
- Encourage and reward
- Be interested







How can you help?:

Detailed:

- Remind them of key dates.
- Help them to organise their work and revision (revision guides, resources).
- Recognise when they are tired/stressed.
- Create an environment where they can fail <u>and</u> improve

Sixth Form IS **DIFFERENT** to school


Studying at Sixth Form allows you to keep the best bits of school, but enter a more adult education environment.
