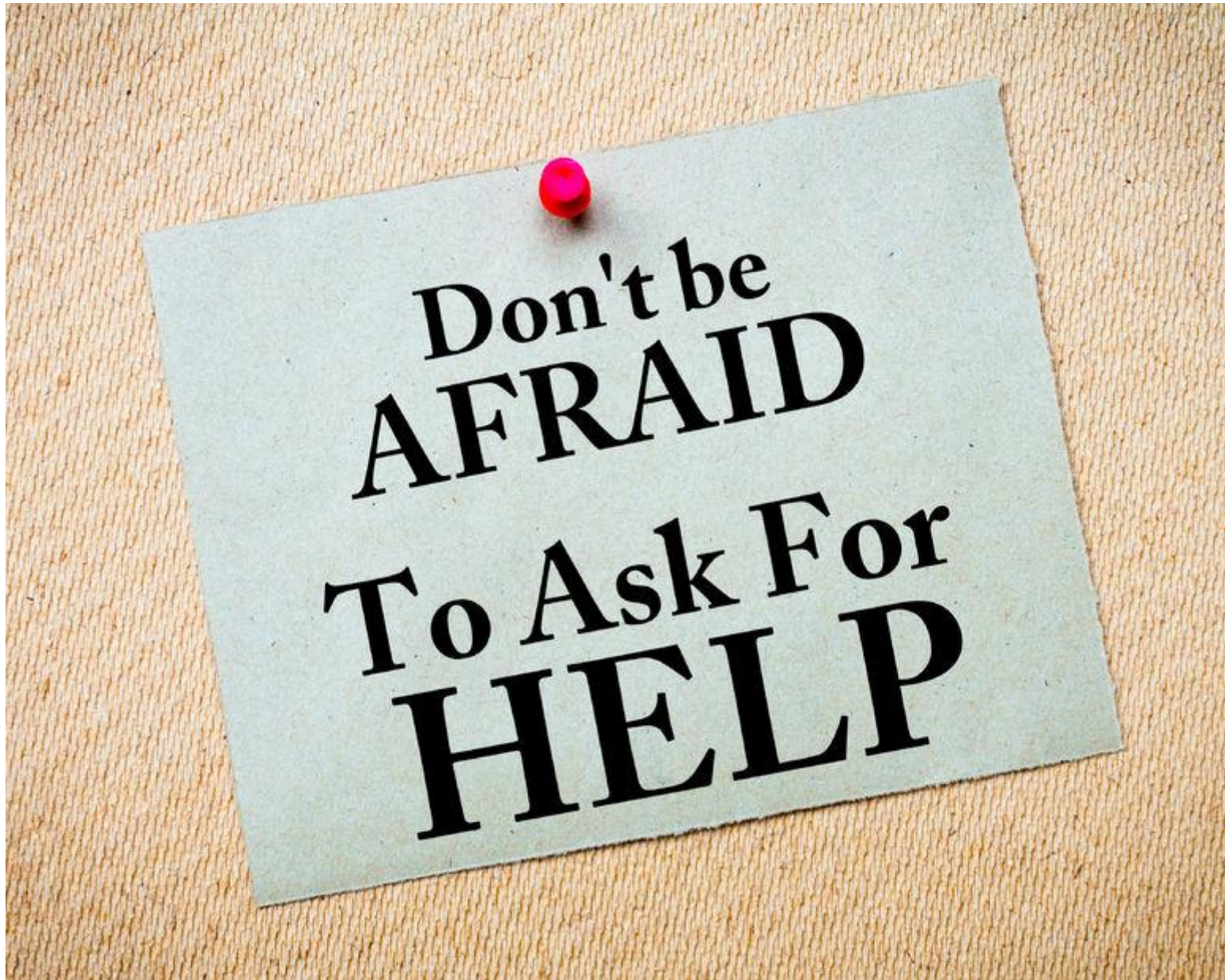
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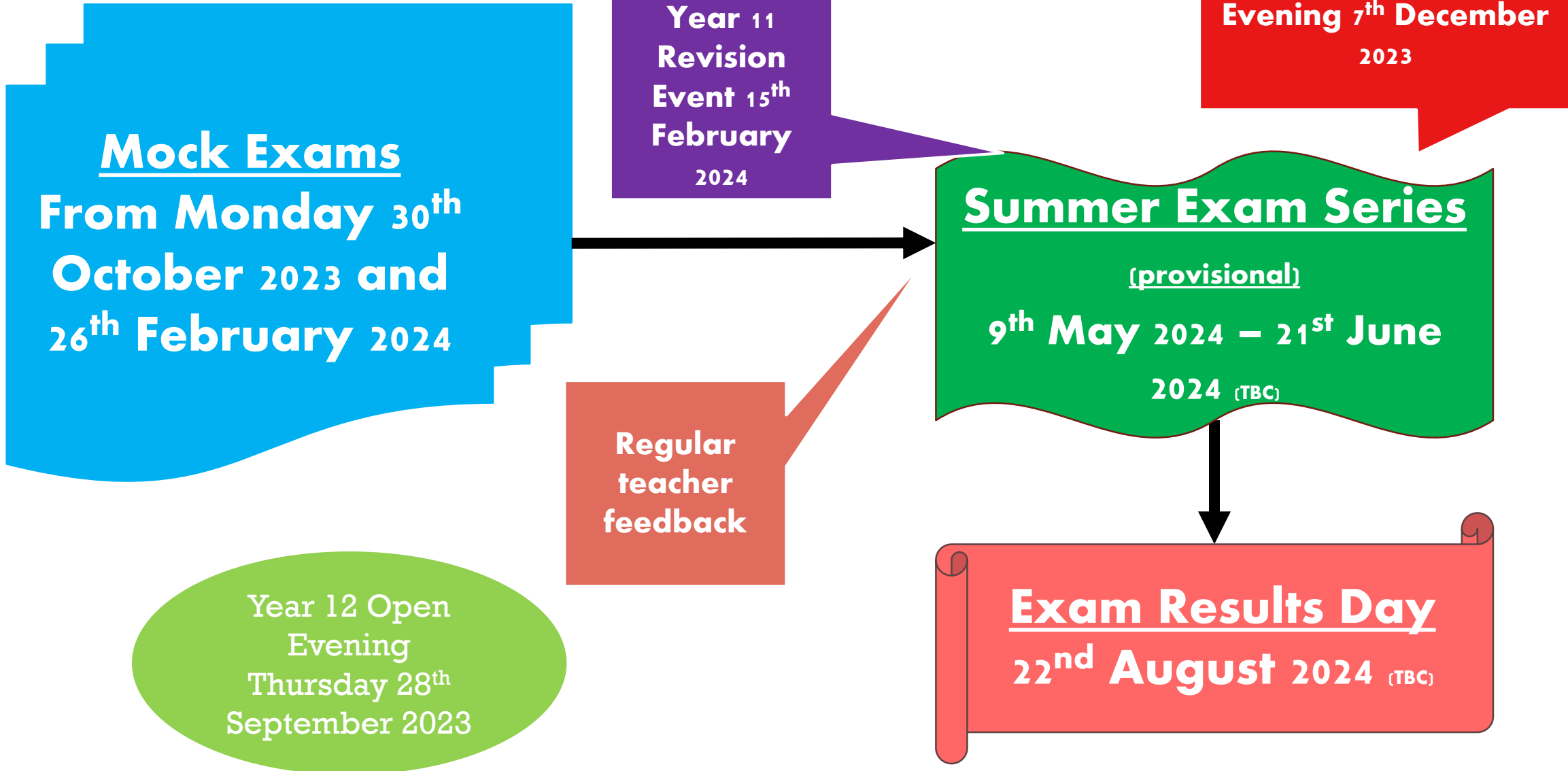

School leaving age

Your school leaving age depends on where you live

England

You can leave school on the last Friday in June if you'll be 16 by the end of the summer holidays.

You must then do one of the following until you're 18:

- stay in full-time education, for example at a college
- start an [apprenticeship](#) or [traineeship](#)
- spend 20 hours or more a week working or volunteering, while in part-time education or training



Help You Choose Guidance & Getting Your Place

What are my choices?

- GCSEs are known as level 1/2 courses. Most students should go on to study level 3 courses.
- A Levels – most will choose renowned A-level **specialists** like Taverham Sixth Form.
- Vocational Courses - More closely linked with routes into employment – often centres like City College.
- Apprenticeships – contract of employment with pay and training.

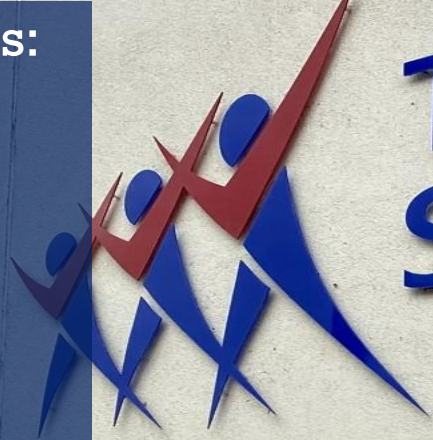
