Research suggests that a Year 10/11 pupil who misses 19 days or more during their school year, will get one grade less at GCSE.

90% attendance = ½ day missed every week!!



1 school year at 90% attendance = 4 whole weeks of lessons MISSED!!!

5 school years at 90% attendance = 1/2 a year of lessons MISSED!!!

Your school leaving age depends on where you live.



England

You can leave school on the last Friday in June if you'll be 16 by the end of the summer holidays.

You must then do one of the following until you're 18:

- stay in full-time education, for example at a college
- start an apprenticeship
- spend 20 hours or more a week working or volunteering, while in part-time education or training




Application Guidance & Getting Your Place



What are my choices?

- GCSEs are known as level 1 or 2 courses. Most students go on to study level 3 courses.
- A Levels most students will choose renowned A-level <u>specialists</u>, like Taverham Sixth Form.
- Vocational Courses (BTEC, CTEC, T Levels)- More closely linked with routes into employment often at centres like City College and Easton College.
- Apprenticeships contract of employment with pay and training.





Application Guidance & Getting Your Place



- Certain places are very competitive e.g. apply early to Taverham to avoid disappointment!
- One 6th form requires 5 'grade 6' or above (including English, Maths and a Language)
- All qualifications count (even short courses taken)
- Any other relevant experience, leadership etc.
- Getting your interview technique and application right


