Collect my child promptly if they develop symptoms while they are at school	
Notify the school promptly if my household needs to isolate so that my child can be moved to a separate area for collection or come straight home

Do not stand around or gather in the school car park	
Ensure my child is in in full clean school uniform – PE Kit to be worn all day on the days of timetabled PE lessons ONLY (for any uniform issues please contact your child's Head of Year)	
Ensure my child brings only required equipment for learning to school every day (for any equipment issues please contact your child's Head of Year)
