Dear Parent/Carer

Year 11 and Year 13 - Revision Sessions

With the Easter holidays fast approaching, and then only a few weeks until the start of the GCSE and A-level examination season, I wanted to write to you, to let you know when the in-school revision sessions are available to the students over the break, as well as to give you an idea of the level of work that students should be putting in to revising over the fortnight that they are not at school.

It is vital that students maintain momentum with their learning over the Easter break, but it is also important that they plan some downtime and leisure activities to ensure they return to us refreshed and ready for the 'final push'.

We are often asked, by parent/carers, how much revision is the 'right amount' for students to be undertaking at this stage of the year. Over the Easter break, it is essential that students complete at least 30 hours of revision. To put this into context, this is only 1 hour and 35 minutes per day. We would, of course, encourage much more, but this is the bare minimum that students should be completing. Those of you who were able to attend the Year 11 Revision evening will have heard me talk of the importance of planning revision, so I will take this opportunity to reiterate this point. Students should, by now, be creating weekly revision plans to structure their learning. To support students with their revision, my colleagues have kindly agreed to put on some revision/study sessions, shown on page 2, over Monday 3 April 2023 and Tuesday 4 April 2023, when the school site is available to us. Most of these sessions are suitable for all who study the subject; however, some are by invitation or appointment only, due to their bespoke nature. Details of the sessions available and how to sign up are on the attachments to this letter.

Unfortunately, if students are poorly behaved or are not working, they will be asked to leave, and you will be made aware of this.

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Revision/Study Sessions:

When your child/ward comes into school for any revision/study session it is essential, for fire regulations, that they sign in at Reception *(there will be sign in sheets in the Reception area)* and sign out as they leave the school site. Students will need to wait in Reception to be picked up by a member of staff and taken to their session, and anyone arriving late will not be able to access school and will miss the session. For their own health and safety, at no time should students be wandering around the site, they must only be in their designated rooms. This is particularly important as we will be having work completed by external contractors over the break and we cannot guarantee your child/ward's safety if they do not stay in the designated areas.

Students will need to bring in their own food and drink, as they will not be able to access catering services at school.

Thank you for your ongoing support through what has been a really hard term for students and families, with lots of hard work and extra revision sessions. The Year 11's and Year 13's are coping really well with the rigours and demands of the GCSE courses they are taking and the next few months are about consolidating that hard work into results.

Your child/ward should already have received their personalised timetable for the final exams in the Summer term. If this is not the case, please contact Mrs C Haywood, our Exams Manager at c_haywood@taverhamhigh.org and she will be able to assist with this.

Finally, please could I ask that you take the time to discuss your child/ward's revision plans with them over the next week and let me know if there is anything else that we can do to support you with your child/ward's progress.
