Grades

Separate Science grades come from the aggregate of the paper 1 and 2 marks for each subject. <u>Grades for Biology, Chemistry and Physics are independent of each other</u> and are a single number from 1 to 9.

Combined Science grades come from the aggregate of all 6 papers. They are 2 grades from 1 to 9 which cannot be more than 1 grade apart, e.g. 5-5, 6-7. The numbers do not relate to any particular subject's grade.

Required Practicals

These are a variety of practical activities that students may have to plan, will always either carry out themselves or occasionally see demonstrated by a teacher and the analyses and evaluate their findings.

There are a total of 21 for Combined Science and 28 for Separate Sciences.

Students will either be given a booklet or individual worksheets to fill in when completing these.

There is no assessment of how they perform these in class, however, students can be asked about all aspects of these in their exams.

Key Dates for GCSE Science Internal Assessment

Tracking Tests and Mock Exams

Year 10 & 11 are tracked at 3 points in each academic year. To help provide accurate data we have developed "tracking exams". It is compulsory that all students do these under exam conditions in class. These are papers made by Heads of Subjects which reflect the style and level of questions they will face in the real exams. There are 2 tiers available.
