WHY IS ENRICHMENT IMPORTANT?



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- **594,940** UCAS applications were made in Jan 2024 (UCAS.com, Feb 2024)
- **337,140** apprenticeship starts in 2022/23 – only **53,258** apprenticeship starts in the East of England Region (statistics.service.gov.uk)
- Those entering the workplace **lack** interpersonal skills, confidence and motivation, critical thinking, innovation and creative thinking. (Deloitte Millennial Survey, 2018)
- It is our responsibility to ensure you are equipped to be successful when leaving school.

WHAT DOES 'ENRICHMENT' LOOK LIKE AT TAVERHAM 6TH FORM?



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- 2 hours a fortnight of timetabled activities
- Community based opportunities – both inside and outside school
- Guest speakers from different career paths
- One day events and visits to help inform your choices following 6th Form
- Work Experience Week
- Subject specific trips

TIMETABLED PROGRAMME



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- *Extended Project Qualification** – develop a project on any topic you like to gain an accredited qualification
- *Film Club* – watch and critique different directors, genres and time periods
- *Financial Trading Club* - learn to trade all sorts of financial instruments without risk through a virtual account, competing with others to make the most money (prizes for winners!)
- *Grub on a Grant* – cooking skills and meal preparation
- *Health and Well-being* – a sports and exercise opportunity to have a go at familiar, as well as more obscure, sports to improve health and well-being during your studies. Trips out for external activities will entail costs.
- *KS3 Paired Reading* - paired reading will involve listening to a KS3 student (usually in Year 7 or Year 8 who needs a little bit more support), read once a week. You will help to ignite an enjoyment of reading and support the student with their reading through listening and discussing the book they have chosen. This is a great opportunity to act as a mentor to lower school students and make a real difference.

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- *Classroom Support* - within school
- *Lower school mentoring* – Yr I I revision support, reading buddies
- *Lunchtime Club* – do you have an interest that you would like to share with lower school?
- *Community Support* – volunteering opportunities with Norfolk Museums Service, local care homes and local community groups

- Independently organised volunteering – e.g. wildlife opportunities
