



Philosophy, Religion & Ethics

Core content: A critical approach to the consideration of moral and philosophical issues. Students study the theories of philosophers such as Plato, Socrates, Aristotle and Aquinas as well as contemporary discourse from Bertrand Russell and Richard Dawkins. The course is split into three papers which are: Unit 1: a study of Christianity -33.5% of A-level Unit 2: philosophy of religion -33.5% of A-level Unit 3: religion and ethics - 33.5% of A-level.

Trips include a visit to the Royal Courts of Justice and Old Bailey in London
