Preparation

Read an article from a broadsheet newspaper – or an online article (The Times, Independent, Telegraph, Guardian) that interests you and complete the following tasks:



- Summarise in your own words what the article is about
 - Consider the purpose of the piece is it to inform? Persuade? Advice? Entertain?
 - Has the writer achieved their purpose and how do you know? Write a reflective statement explaining HOW the writer has achieved their purpose by commenting on the language use

Question: "The facilities in our local area could be improved" Write a letter to the local council explaining your views, ideas and suggestions on the statement.
