

INDEPENDENT STUDY – Preparation Consolidation Reflection

Preparation

- 1 Complete wider reading log each week. Use the resources which are outlined on the log to inform reading.
 - 2 Look at the unit specification and make notes on future learning outcomes.
 - 3- Ensure your folder reflects the outcomes outlines on the unit specification.
- 4 Keep up to date with relevant and contemporary issues within Health and Social Care using resources such as Google scholar, scholarly articles and newspapers.

Consolidation

- 1 Using notes create revision cards for exam units (Yr 12 Unit 4, Yr 13 Unit 2, 3)
- 2 Complete coursework using the task sheets and unit specifications.
- 3 Respond to feedback provided on re-drafted work.
- 4 Complete past exam questions which are found on the OCR website for exam units.
- 5 Ensure electronic and physical folders are organised with sections for each learning outcome and an assessment tab.

Reflection

- 1 Using notes create revision cards for exam units (Yr 12 Unit 4, Yr 13 Unit 2, 3)
- 2 Make a glossary of key words/ command words.
- 3 Complete re-drafted coursework.
- 4 Use recall activities such as past exam questions, revision cards and knowledge maps to practice retrieval.
