## WHY IS ENRICHMENT IMPORTANT?

- **616,360** UCAS applications were made in Jan 2021 (UCAS.com, June 2021)
- **322,500** apprenticeship starts in 2019/20 – only **32,300** apprenticeship starts in the East of England Region (House of Commons Briefing Paper, March 2021)
- Those entering the workplace **lack** interpersonal skills, confidence and motivation, critical thinking, innovation and creative thinking. (Deloitte Millennial Survey, 2018)
- It is our responsibility to ensure you are equipped to be successful when leaving school.
